JOSIAH'S MESSAGE WAS SIMPLE...he was giving up on God. At Need Him **Global**, we talk with people from all walks of life. Sometimes those conversations are really difficult and it feels like the message is falling on deaf ears. Cotey started this hard discussion but would be surprised as it progressed to the point of true friendship and ended with a clear choice about Jesus.

Cotey is part of the Resident Leadership Program and has always been active in answering text messages. One day last September, he received a message from a young man named Josiah. Josiah's message was simple... he was giving up on God. As they talked via text, Cotey learned that Josiah was 20 years old, he also was a father of a oneyear old girl and...he was fighting brain cancer. Josiah did not feel like God was listening to his prayers and he was frustrated and losing hope. Cotey shared how God hears all prayers and how our relationship with Jesus can influence how we pray. They discussed the Gospel and the need for forgiveness. They texted one another multiple times each week throughout the fall and got to know one another. They shared stories about their first car, first date and first job but Cotey always brought it back to Josiah giving up his heart to Jesus.

I hope so.

I think I'm searching. Not really sure. He's been on my mind quite a bit lately and it's eating at me. I don't know where to start or what to do.

That's ok. I'm glad you've been thinking about this, and that you are here to look more closely.

I don't understand how to ask for forgiveness or be a godly person. There are a lot of things that I do that would get me kicked out at the Holy Gates, if you know what I mean.

One of the amazing things about how the love of God works is that He understands that we are all fallen, broken, sinful and lost. God shows us His love and grace and offers us forgiveness while we don't even deserve it.

Is it a one shot thing? You ask for forgiveness and from that point on you have to walk the perfect line?

Being forgiven and entering into a real relationship with God happens all at once and then we have the privilege of growing closer to Him.

If I ask for forgiveness from Him, how do I know that I am forgiven?

You can know that you are saved because Jesus says that if we have believed in Him and in His Father in heaven, that we can be saved

This may be a silly question, but how does one go about praying?

It's not silly at all. If you believe that you are a sinner separated from God and that you cannot earn your own forgiveness - but need Jesus, you can pray confessing this and placing your faith in Him.

I am a sinner and I know that I need Him. I have everything I think I need and I think I'm happy, but deep down I'm not. I just don't know how to get to Him or find Him in my heart.

If you believe these things that we have been talking about, let me type here an example of what you could pray to place your faith and trust in Him.

Okay

Jesus, I understand that I have rebelled against you and I have done wrong- that I have sinned. And I confess that I am a sinner in need of a Savior. I know that I cannot save myself and I know and believe that you are God's son sent to die for my sin. I know that you rose from the dead and will give me new life in you and with you forever. I receive your payment of death for me and trust you with my life.

Josiah eventually moved to Pennsylvania for experimental treatment for his brain cancer and unfortunately, that did not go well. In through assisted suicide options. He talked that over with Cotey and came to learn through their conversations how much God values life. There was clearly a friendship and a bond between

these two young men. Josiah admitted that all Hello this is he really wanted was to Josiah's see his daughter grow uncle. I'm up - but that would likely not happen. Cotey sent him a text on Christmas Eve and Josiah waited for Josiah's reply. The reply never After a few came. weeks, in early January, Cotey received a text asking if he was the young man sharing Jesus with Josiah. He replied yes and received the following message from Josiah's family: They told him that Josiah wanted them to thank Cotey for all he had done and to let

because he did give his heart to *Jesus* before he passed away.

In some ways there will never be another conversation like this one. In other ways, someone through Need Him Global does this

every day by answering a stranger and meeting them where they are with the only true message of hope.



I feel 25 lbs lighter. I want to do this. I hope I can do it correctly.

> You can do it because He is with you and in you. I want you to know that the Bible promises once you please your faith in Jesus, that nothing in all creation can ever separate you from His love.

However, something truly special happens when you combine the easy ability of text messaging to carry on a conversation over time with the Resident Leadership Program that provides a regular and recurring opportunity for committed future church leaders to develop these types of conversations and ultimately relationships.

We hope to expand the Resident Leadership Program to seminaries around the country and eventually the world. As Dr. Mark Bailey of Dallas Theological Seminary recently said ... "for those that are part of the resident program it's all made even more real by engaging people and helping them realize that grace is real... God is working... and the *Gospel transforms lives.*" We are humbled and honored by those that have partnered with us in various ways to add this program to all we do to serve the kingdom. We look forward to the day when even more residents can invest into a life the way Cotey did with Josiah.
