



THE GROWING PORN EPIDEMIC

We live in a rapidly changing world where traditional values and beliefs are increasingly viewed as narrow minded

or uninformed. Community is moving away from traditional personal relationships into online personas. The result is a world growing in hidden pain.

As this change happens before our very eyes, Need Him Global has a front row seat to how culture is changing and the resulting impact on society. But there is one issue that has exploded in the past year and represents an epidemic of pain and brokenness. That issue is pornography.

You may be thinking that is no surprise based on the prevalent availability of pornography online and the growing acceptability of it in culture. However, there is more to this problem than you think. We see almost 50% of our conversations on this topic coming from women. We regularly see teenagers that have been involved with pornography for years. A recent landmark study on the problem showed that more than one in four (26%) young people aged 18-24 seek porn out weekly. A growing number of teens are "sexting" meaning receiving or sending sexually explicit images via text message. And maybe most discouragingly, less than one-third (32%) of young adults say viewing porn is "usually or always wrong".

The result is a growing number of conversations each day with young people that are desperately seeking some biblical truth and help around this issue. A growing number of conversations are with people that are watching a marriage come apart and want help for their spouse. The result is that we are always looking for solid resources to share. There are some good accountability software programs to track phone and computer use but many seekers also want something they can lean on that is based on biblical principles and putting Jesus at the heart of change. We wanted to offer something that would help people be set free from the destructive patterns of lust, guilt, emptiness and broken promises.





The result was that the ministry created a reading plan specifically for women struggling with pornography and another specifically for men. We published these plans the first week of March with no advertising or media. We have already had over 20,000 people subscribe to the plans and start walking with Jesus to find hope and healing from pornography. Him Global existed it was primarily a phone ministry using an assortment of telephony solutions. Then media opportunities to share the Gospel changed and it became clear that the ministry would need to use things like online chat, text messaging and social media if we wanted to reach all people. The challenge was there were no response systems that would handle all those different response technologies and help with evangelism.

The ministry was fortunate to have partners that would allow us to use world class systems but those were focused on managing customer relationships and selling more products. After much prayer, the ministry eventually made the decision to invest in building a system specifically for sharing the Gospel and nothing else.

Echo is that evangelism response system. This revolutionary technology solution allows volunteers to log in securely and remotely to respond to seekers from all over the world. It is specifically designed for evangelism with training and resources specific to

sharing the Gospel. It is a cloud based platform that incorporates phone calls, online chats, text messages and emails into a single response system that can be used by volunteers anywhere they have internet access.

In the Spring of 2014, the latest and most current version of Echo was launched. When the former President of the Southern Baptist International Mission Board saw it, he said ... "Echo could be the tool that God uses to complete the Great Commission! Echo is the piece we will need to accomplish this in our lifetime."

In less than three years, the system has handled over 1 million conversations across phone, online chat, text messaging and email. We now have ministry partners around the globe using the system and contributing to its maintenance costs. The system is easily converted to other languages so some of those ministries are having conversations within Echo in different languages like Spanish, Farsi, Uzbek and Azerbaijani.

We are grateful for your support and that of our technology partner. That team has been instrumental in developing, maintaining and advancing this lifeline to conversations with seekers. We are grateful for this incredible technology and look forward to the next million conversations that share the Gospel and the one true message of hope found in Jesus Christ.

Paul was this super religious guy. Jesus was preaching what Paul and his fellow leaders thought was going against God. So Paul decided to do something about the people who were following Jesus. He would kill anyone who claimed to follow Jesus and he was very good at it

And what happened after did he stop and ask for forgiveness?

Paul was blinded. While he was blind Jesus told Paul to stop. Paul's eyes were healed and he then wanted to follow Jesus. Paul went on to become one of the greatest missionaries ever and wrote much of the New Testament But he never forgot how he hurt Jesus and the people he had killed.

Tell us about your childhood

I feel very blessed that my parents were followers of Jesus in a country where 97% of people are Muslims and only 1.5% consider themselves Christian. My friends would challenge me to believe Islam and claim the Bible had been hopelessly corrupted. I would think to myself, how can it be that I alone am right and all of them wrong. This is what got me interested in apologetics.

What was your education like in Pakistan?

I attended a private university and started taking courses in Christian studies. It was there that I heard a teacher say that the only reason one can be put right with God is through Jesus Christ. This is when I fully accepted Christ's righteousness and knew that God called me to ministry.

Worth and lead a Bible study for international students at University of Texas at Arlington. Most of the members of the group come from various backgrounds and nationalities.

What has been your experience doing online evangelism with Need Him Global?

Working with Need Him has impacted me greatly. Every day I get to share the Gospel with people from around the world. I have talked to atheists, agnostics, Muslims, Hindus, and countless others.
